Answering major questions

1. How to register?

Registration is complete with sending in the filled registration form directly to the Bildungszentrum.

A direct debit authorisation is obligatory for German citizens. As non-residents you might ask for permission to pay cash at arrival.

Important: If you have given direct debit authorisation the money is charged **after** your participation.

You can apply for both weekends on one form.

2. How are the local conditions?

Accommodation (meals and rooms) in Langscheid are organised in the same house.

The Schützenhalle - the hall we dance in - is located approx. 500m from the lodging.

4. What else is important?

There are **no** Badges and Dangles available for this event.

The event is **limited to 60 dancers** due to the size of the hall.

At the Bildungszentrum **only 6 single room** are available. With the expected high demand the available double rooms are **not** awarded to singles.

The house provides a limited range of beverages and drinks in the hall (mineral water for the daytime and beer for the afterparty). You will have to mark your consumed numbers in a list and pay at the Bildungszentrum before departure. A greater variety of drinks and beverages is available at the Bildungszentrum itself and can be brought to the hall on your own.

A consistent supply on coffee and tea is **not** provided. However, with the coffee break on Saturday besides cake there will also be coffee available in the hall.
